BACKPACK PROGRAM

A staggering 14 million children in the United States suffer from the clutches of food insecurity—a harrowing figure exacerbated by recent unprecedented events. The North Country is no stranger to this crisis. While the national child poverty rate doubled in the last year to a significant 12.4%, Franklin County and surrounding areas realized an even graver milestone reaching 27.1% — a reminder of the formidable challenge ahead.

As the emergency allotments to the SNAP program wound down in March, organizations committed to alleviating food insecurity bore witness to a surge in the number of families relying on food shelves and community programs, like the Backpack Program, to ensure their children had full bellies. The cessation of the enhanced child tax credits further deepened the wounds, pulling the rug from under families who were barely keeping their heads above turbulent waters.

In the midst of prevailing adversities that have cast a daunting shadow over our community, the Backpack Program has emerged as a ray of light, illuminating paths of possibility and promise. Hunger doesn't pause for weekends or school holidays, and neither does our unwavering commitment to ensuring no child goes hungry. Each year, we channel the collective efforts of our compassionate community to providing meals to children in our region experiencing food insecurity. This year the Backpack Program touched the lives of 455 local children across seven school districts, delivering 55,800 meals.

In the face of adversity, the Backpack Program stands resilient and resolute. Our mission transcends the mere act of providing meals—our goal is to instill hope, ensure academic success, and forge a future where childhood hunger is a memory. Every nutritious meal is a testament of our pledge to our community's children—a promise of brighter, nourished tomorrows.


